Special Building to Cost \$20,000 May Be Erected Here.

Plans are now being made for the erection at a cost of about \$20,000 of a building for use by the local department of the United States Weather Bureau. The Secretary of Agriculture has approved the recommendation of Professor Willis L. Moore, chief of the bureau, for such a building. The appropriation asked for by Congressman John Lamb has been favorably passed upon by the committee.

Section Director **Edward A. Evans** yesterday afternoon stated that he could not say anything of the plans, but he felt sure the building would be erected here. The quarters now occupied by the bureau in the Mutual Building are much too small.
