

Meteorological Report for June.

The subjoined report gives sunrise, minimum and maximum readings of the thermometer, the course of the wind at sunrise, and the amount of rainfall for the month of June.

The readings of the thermometer were taken in an elevated portion of the city, the position of the instruments being free from any influence of refracted heat. They are self-registering, of the very best French manufacture, and the figures are believed to be absolutely correct:

* Rain measurements are made each morning at 7 o'clock. This having fallen the last day of May is counted with this month.

- (1) High wind and rain at night.
- (2) Light rain at night.
- (3) Light rain in the afternoon and at night.
- (4) Heavy showers late at night.
- (5) Light showers in the afternoon.
- (6) Thunder-storm and rain in the afternoon.
- (7) Thunder-storm and rain about noon.
- (8) Thunder-storm and rain about noon and rain all the afternoon and at night.
- (9) Thunder-storm in the afternoon, with light rain.
- (10) Thunder-storm, with light rain at night.
- (11) Two thunder-storms followed each other in rapid succession about noon, accompanied with heavy rain.

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We give below a table showing the mean temperature and the amount of rainfall during the corresponding month for the past twelve years:
