

THE WEATHER IN JUNE.

Conditions Through the Month— Temperature and Rainfall.

The subjoined report gives sunrise, minimum and maximum readings of the thermometer, and the amount of rainfall for the month of June.

The readings of the thermometer were taken on an elevated plateau near the city, the position of the instruments being free from any influence of refracted heat. They are self-registering, of the very best French manufacture, and the figures are believed to be absolutely correct:

Mean temperature, 78.8.

1. Light shower; thunder-storm at night.
2. Showers at night, with some lightning.
3. A few drops of rain about noon.
4. Very light showers during the day and at night.
5. Very light showers about noon and at night.
6. A few light showers during the day.
7. Rain and lightning in the afternoon; lightning at night.
8. Light drizzle at night.
9. Showers in the afternoon and at night, with little lightning.
10. Light showers and thunder-storm about noon and early in the night.
11. Showers; thunder-storm late in the afternoon.
12. Heavy thunder-storm, with high wind and rain in the afternoon; light rain at night.
13. Light rain and thunder-storm about noon.

Rainfall for the month, 2.07 inches.

(There was a heavy fall of rain Sunday night, June 30th, the measurement of which will appear in the record for July.)

In the table below will be found the mean temperature, and the average amount of rainfall during the corresponding month for the past sixteen years:
