1. Light rain at night.
2. Light showers in the afternoon.
3. Thunder-storm and rain at night.
4. Light showers late at night.
5. Light showers in the forenoon; thunder-storm in the afternoon, with shower at night.
6. Rain most of the day, with heavy showers at night.
7. Heavy rain about noon; thunder-storm in the afternoon, and light rain at night.
8. Thunder-storm, and showers at night.
9. Thunder-storm in the afternoon, with light rain at night.
10. Thunder-storm in the afternoon, and rain early at night.
11. Rain in the afternoon.
12. Rain about noon.
13. Rain in the afternoon.
14. Light rain in the afternoon.

Rainfall for the month, 6.09 inches.

Measurements of rain made at 7 o'clock each morning.

The amount of downpour for the month just passed, it will be seen, has been equalled only once in the last seventeen years, that of 1889 excelling it by nearly two inches.

During the month there were fifteen clear days, and fifteen cloudy or partly cloudy at 7 o'clock in the morning, the time at which observations are taken.

In the table below will be found the mean temperature, and the average amount of rainfall during the corresponding month for the past seventeen years:
