On the 31st of October rain fell to the amount of 1.80 inches, but as the measurement was taken at 4:30 on that day and 1.20 inches was reported only .60 inch is added to this table.

1. Rain at night.
2. Light showers early in the night.
3. Rain late at night and early in the morning.
4. Rain all day.
5. A little snow; rain and hail at night.
6. Fine, misty rain all day.
7. Light shower at night.
8. Fog all day, with light showers at night.
9. Light showers, accompanied by thunder and lightning early in the forenoon.

Measurements of rainfall taken each morning.

At the time of observation there were 19 cloudy and partly cloudy days, and 11 clear. Rain fell on 9 days or nights. Frost formed on 7 nights.
