

# Tropical Storm Approaches Texas

NEW ORLEANS, Sept. 22—(AP)—Tropical storm Flossy, growing stronger, headed toward the Louisiana and upper Texas coasts Saturday night amid indications that it would reach hurricane force by Sunday.

In its latest advisory at 5 p. m. (CST), the Weather Bureau advised a hurricane watch for the two-state coastal area and warned small craft from Corpus Christi, Tex., to Apalachicola, Fla., to remain in port.

The advisory placed the storm's center about 450 miles south of New Orleans.

Flossy, spotted first over the Yucatan peninsula, carried highest winds 45 to 55 miles an hour in heaviest squalls. The Weather Bureau said the winds extended out 350 miles to east and north of the storm's center.

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
