

A weak EF1 tornado with 90-100mph winds was confirmed over Downers Grove (where my coworkers Guy, Yoon, and Tim live)... the tornado tracked literally right over Guy's house where we have our poker nights every so often. I took a run around the neighborhood Wed. night and heard the sound of generators from the 400 or so in Oak Park who were without power.
