

This historic snow storm dumped 11.0" here at Westmont PA, 10.8" of which fell yesterday 10/29.

Looking through well over 100 years of records for Johnstown, Ebensburg, Somerset etc. this was probably the greatest October snow storm on record. Over a foot fell on the favored higher elevations, e.g. Blue Knob, Mt. Davis, Laurel Summit. I have attached a few pictures, showing the high amounts of snow on the ground and many of the smaller trees/shrubs severely bent due to the snow's weight. Pretty amazing storm.
