Midwest Storm Totals

Top Five Snowstorms All-time

- **Portland, Maine:** All-time record snowstorm (31.9"); Old record from Jan. 17-18, 1979 (27.1")
- **Hartford, Conn.:** (Bradley Field): Second-heaviest snowfall on record (22.3"); record is from Jan. 12, 2011 (24").

- **Worcester, Mass.:** Third heaviest snowstorm all-time (28.7"); Record is 33" from "April Fools' 1997".
- **Concord, N.H.:** Second heaviest snowstorm all-time (24").
- **Boston (Logan Airport):** Fifth heaviest snowstorm on record (24.9").
