Nov-01	VERY PLEASANT WARM FALL DAY WITH A 37 DEGREE TEMP. RANGE
Nov-02	SOME CIRRUS IN AM BUT MOSTLY CLEAR WITH CLOUDS COMING IN AT 1340 THEN REMAINING CLOUDY UNTIL SUNSET
Nov-03	CLOUDY ALL DAY - LOW PRESSURE TO SE AND HIGH PRESSURE TO NE
Nov-04	MODERATE AM FOG-THERE WAS ALSO 4 MORE SHOWERS THAT CAME LATER IN DAY THAT GAVE ONLY ABOUT 0.01 INCH
Nov-05	RAINBOW 1650 - 1705 - 3 OTHER PERIODS OF A FEW SPRINKLES-5TH PRECIP. PERIOD 2340-2400
Nov-06	BREEZY CLOUDY DAY WITH AM PERIODS OF SPRINKLES-3RD PRECIP. PERIOD 0950-1000
Nov-07	ONLY A FEW FAIR WEATHER CUMULUS AROUND 1300-1320 OTHERWISE CLEAR
Nov-08	IT STARTED TO CLEAR AT 1040 AND WAS CLEAR BY 1130 THEN A FEW CUMULUS FROM 1240-1400
Nov-09	TOTALLY CLEAR UNTIL 1320 THEN PARTLY CLOUDY UNTIL 1420 THEN CLOUDY UNTIL SUNSET-ESTIMATED PM CLOUDS 65%
Nov-10	BEAUTIFUL CLEAR DAY WITH A COOL START BUT WARMED UP NEARLY WITH A 27 DEGREE TEMP. RANGE-100% SUN
Nov-11	COLDEST MORNING OF THE FALL SEASON-THIN CIRRUS STARTED COMING IN AT 1100 AND IT WAS A TOTAL CLOUD COVER BY 1400 OF ALTO CUMULUS
Nov-12	3RD PERIOD OF PRECIP. FROM 1440-1525 AND A RAINBOW SEEN DURING PD. FROM 1610-1620
Nov-13	VERY DARK AND DAMP DAY PARTICULARLY THE PM - HEAVY FOG AFTER DARK-3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 2230-2400
Nov-14	HEAVY FOG -3RD PD. OF PRECIP.. 0220-2155, 4TH PD. 1610-1625, 5TH PD. 1723-1915
Nov-15	LIGHT FOG AND VERY WINDY AND MILD DAY-DEW POINT REACH HIGH OF 67.3 °F-VERY INTENSE RAIN IN THUNDERSTORM DURING EARLY AM
Nov-16	PM HAD SOME CUMULUS CLOUDS BUT LESS THAN 20% CLOUDY
Nov-17	MANY CIRRUS UNTIL 0950 THEN ALTOCUMULUS UNTIL 1040 AND MAINLY CIRRUS AND ALTOCUMULUS AGAIN DURING PM
Nov-18	FIRST SNOW FLURRY-3RD PD. OF PREP.. 1503-1506 THE HEAVIEST SNOW FLURRY-VIRGA SEEN TODAY
Nov-19	COLDEST AM OF FALL-ALMOST TOTALLY CLOUDY AFTER 1530
Nov-20	WARMER AND PARTLY CLOUDY WITH LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY
Nov-21	VERY COLD AND WINDY AFTERNOON-MIN. WIND CHILL WAS 21 °F AND MIN. DEW POINT TEMP. WAS 8.1 °F
Nov-22	VERY DRY AIR AND LOW DEW POINT OF 9.7 °F-FIRST CLOUDS CAME IN AROUND 1310
Nov-23	COLDEST OF THE FALL BY 0.7 °F-WARMER TODAY BUT STILL CHILLY
Nov-24	CIRRUS FROM SUNRISE TO 810 THEN CLEAR UNTIL 0940 THEN PC WITH CIRRUS AND ALTOCUMULUS BY 1250 AND ALTOSTRATUS BY 1420-CLOUDY TO SUNSET
Nov-25	DOUBLE COLD FRONT PASSAGE TODAY - 2ND COLD FRONT CAUSED ONLY PM CLOUDS
Nov-26	CLOUDS CAME IN AT 0930
Nov-27	30 DEGREE TEMP. RANGE TODAY
Nov-28	WARM CLOUDY DAY WITH LITTLE WIND
Nov-29	CLOUDY FROM SUNRISE TO 1030 AND CLEAR FROM 1050-1310 THE MOSTLY CLOUDY TO 1510 AND THEN CLOUDY TO SUNSET
Nov-30	RAINY GLOOMY AND A DARK DAY
