Dec-01	THUNDER AT 0552, 0554, 0557-RAPID CLEARING AROUND 1030 - AM ABOUT 64% CLOUDY
Dec-02	CLOUDS CAME IN AROUND 0830 AND PM WAS ALMOST TOTAL CLOUD COVERAGE WITH CIRRUS
Dec-03	AM WAS CLEAR AND CLOUDS STARTED COMING IN AROUND 1100 AND WAS TOTALLY CLOUDY BY 1300
Dec-04	PC IN AM AND TOTAL CLOUDS AFTER 1420
Dec-05	AFTER MIDNIGHT SNOW SO LIGHT IT WASN'T RECORDED ON PRECIP. SENSOR
Dec-06	CLEAR FOR MOST OF DAY EXCEPT BETWEEN 1115-1330 THEN PARTLY CLOUDY-VERY COLD DRY AIR WITH LOW DEW POINT TEMPS.
Dec-07	COLDEST AM SINCE FEB. 14, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 22 °F
Dec-08	COLDEST AM SINCE FEB. 8, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 14 °F-VERY CLEAR BUT COLD DAY
Dec-09	COLDEST AM SINCE FEB. 8, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 14 °F-4TH CONSECUTIVE DAY OF LOW TEMPS. FOR SEASON
Dec-10	CLOUDY UNTIL ABOUT 1430 THEN CLEARING UNTIL 1645
Dec-11	VISIBILITY ABOUT 0.3 MILES - DAMP DAY WITH RAIN FROM 1110-SUNSET
Dec-12	LOWEST BAROMETER SINCE APRIL 26, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 29.18-SURPRISE SNOW EVENT
Dec-13	LOWEST MAX. TEMP. SINCE JAN. 30, 2010 YET UNDER VERY CLEAR AND SUNNY SKIES
Dec-14	COLDEST AM SINCE FEB. 8, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 14 °F - CLEAR ALL DAY EXCEPT A FEW CLOUDS ON WEST HORIZON AT SUNSET-SNOW STORM TOMORROW IN FORECAST
Dec-15	STEADY SNOW FROM 1000-1400 THEN TAPERING OFF AND A LITTLE SLEET AT THE END
Dec-16	MOSTLY CLOUDY TO 1100 THEN QUICKLY CLEARING WITH ONLY A FEW CIRRUS CLOUDS AFTER 1545
Dec-17	VERY LIGHT AM FOG AND CLOUDY ALL DAY-ATLANTIC STORM PASSED TO FAR TO EAST TO GIVE US SNOW
Dec-18	CLOUDY TO 0945 THEN A QUICK CLEARING WITH NO CLOUDS AT ALL
Dec-19	CLEAR DAY ALL DAY BUT STILL CHILLY FOR DEC.
Dec-20	CLOUDY SKIES CLEARED AT 0815 BUT BECAME CLOUDY AGAIN AT 1100-AM ABOUT 35% CLOUDY
Dec-21	CLOUDY SKIES ALMOST ALL DAY JUST A TOUCH OF SUN IN PM
Dec-22	TRACE OF SNOW ONLY IN SHADOWS AND WHERE PILES WERE MADE-VERY CLEAR DAY
Dec-23	VERY CLEAR BUT COLD DAY BECAUSE OF THE WIND-ONLY A FEW PATCHES OF SNOW LEFT
Dec-24	FEW HARDLY DISCERNIBLE SNOW PELLETS BETWEEN 0730-0830 AND NO OTHER PRECIP. UNTIL SNOW STARTED AT 1430 AND BECAME STEADY AROUND 1630
Dec-25	HEAVIEST SNOW WAS TO OUR EAST AND ALONG THE COAST-PORTSMOUTH HAD 11 INS.-HERE WE HAD SNOW FLURRIES ON AND OFF FROM NOON TO 1930 AND THERE
Dec-26	A FEW SNOW FLURRIES FROM 0030-0035-WE WERE ABOUT THE LOWEST SNOW AMOUNT IN HENRICO CO.
Dec-27	VERY SUNNY AND A LITTLE WARMER BUT STILL A LITTLE BELOW AVERAGE FOR DEC.
Dec-28	PM PARTLY CLOUDY WITH A FEW THIN CIRRUS
Dec-29	A BARELY DISCERNIBLE AM SPRINKLE AND A HEAVIER PM SPRINKLE A LITTLE PAST NOON
Dec-30	WARMER TEMPS. BUT DEC. WILL GO DOWN AS ONE OF THE 10 COLDEST IN THE RICHMOND AREA - THE AM WAS ABOUT 30 % CLOUDY WITH CIRRUS

Dec-26	WERE 7 DIFFERENT PERIODS WITH SNOW FLURRIES HEAVY ENOUGH TO SHOW ON THE PRECIP. INSTRUMENT-MOST SNOW ON GROUND AT ANY ONE TIME WAS 2.7 INCHES
