





Feb 2010	REMARKS FOR THE MONTH February - 2010
Feb-01	BRIGHT SUNNY DAY BUT THROUGH A VERY THIN VEIL OF CIRRUS FIBROUS CLOUDS-LOT OF MELTING OF SNOW IN SUNNY AREAS
Feb-02	SOME SLEET AT 1530 AND TURNED TO A SNOW/RAIN MIX AT 2100
Feb-03	BELOW FREEZING FROM 0550-0745 AND ACCUMULATION ALMOST 95% SLEET - THERE WAS NO SNOW ONLY SLEET AFTER MIDNIGHT
Feb-04	MAJOR WINTER STORM IN FORECAST-CLOUDS CAME IN AT 1000 BUT TOTALLY CLEAR EARLIER
Feb-05	TOTAL SNOW 4.5 INS. AND MAX. WAS TAKEN BEFORE RAIN AND SLEET THEN HEAVY RAIN AFTER 2030
Feb-06	HEAVY RAIN ENDED ABOUT 2330-RAIN AFTER MIDNIGHT TURNED BACK TO SNOW AROUND 0330 BUT NO SLEET OCCURRED AFTER MIDNIGHT-ESTIMATE 1.40 INS. OF LIQUID
Feb-07	SNOW CAMERA DURING NIGHT CAUGHT TIME LAPSE OF FROST CRYSTALS FORMING AND BECOMING SO LARGE THEY COLLAPSED
Feb-08	SOME CIRRUS FROM 1115-1245 BUT THE SUN REDUCED SNOW ON GROUND BY ABOUT 3 INS.-OF COURSE COMPACTING WAS PART OF THIS
Feb-09	SOME CIRRUS IN LATE AM BUT MOSTLY CLEAR AND PM HAD MORE CIRRUS BUT THIN ENOUGH THAT THE SUN SHONE THROUGH
Feb-10	VERY LIGHT SNOW WITH AN 18 TO 1 RATIO-ABOUT 0.1 INS. OF GLAZE OCCURRED BEFORE SNOW AND THIS AMT. WAS NOT ADDED INTO SNOW TOTAL-11 INS. OF SNOW
Feb-11	A BEAUTIFUL DAY WITH 100% SUN-WE LOST 2.5 INS. OF SNOW
Feb-12	1ST CLOUDS CAME IN AT 1245-AM WAS ABOUT 25% CLOUDY AS A SNOWSTORM IS PASSING OVER THE DEEP SOUTH
Feb-13	LIGHT MORNING FLURRIES THAT MELTED ON CONTACT-3RD PD. OF LIGHT SNOW FLURRIES 0915-1130 SO LIGHT THEY MELTED ALSO ON CONTACT
Feb-14	NEAR AVERAGE TEMPS. BUT BREEZE MADE IT FEEL LIKE A CHILLY DAY
Feb-15	LIGHT RAIN MOST OF AFTERNOON
Feb-16	MOSTLY CLEAR IN AM WITH 1ST CLOUDS SEEN AROUND 1015-1045 IN FORM OF CIRRUS THEN CLEARED UP AGAIN UNTIL NOON
Feb-17	PM WAS ABOUT 60% CLOUDY
Feb-18	WARMEST DAY SINCE JAN. 28, 2010
Feb-19	WARMEST DAY SINCE JAN. 28, 2010 AND FIRST 50 °F DAY IN FEB.
Feb-20	WARMEST DAY SINCE JAN. 28, 2010
Feb-21	WARMEST DAY SINCE JAN. 28, 2010 WHEN IT WAS ALSO 59 °F
Feb-22	SNOW ALL GONE EXCEPT IN PILES AND AREAS WHERE DRIFTED
Feb-23	SOME SUN THROUGH CIRRUS IN PM
Feb-24	STILL A LITTLE SNOW WHERE SNOW DRIFTED
Feb-25	A LITTLE SNOW WITH RAIN FROM 0200-0240 BUT WITH TEMP. ABOVE FREEZING NONE OF IT STUCK
Feb-26	AM ABOUT 50% CLOUDY AND WINDY-NJ SNOWSTORM TRACKS NW THEN RETROGRADES SOUTH-SW CIRCULATION AROUND LOW PRESSURE BROUGHT SOME LIGHT
Feb-27	NOT AS MUCH WIND TODAY BUT FEB. WILL GO DOWN AS ONE VERY COLD MONTH WITH MEAN TEMPERATURE 4.5 DEGREES BELOW AVERAGE
Feb-28	THE AVERAGE TEMP. FOR FEB. WAS LOWER THAN THE AVERAGE TEMP. FOR JANUARY
DATE	EXTENSION OF LENGTHY DAILY REMARKS
Feb-04	FELL AS RAIN YESTERDAY OF THE 4.5 INS. OF SNOW. WE LOST 1.7 INS. OF SNOW LEAVING 2.8 INS. ON GROUND AFTER THE HEAVY RAIN JUST BEFORE MIDNIGHT. WE
Feb-10	HAD ABT. 3.5 INS. OF OLD SNOW ON THE GROUND WHEN THIS SNOW BEGAN ON THE 5TH & WE LOST ABOUT 1.5 INS. OF THIS SNOW THAT WAS UNDER THE SNOWBOARD.
Feb-26	ON GROUND WHEN THE SNOW ENDED AND 9.5 INS. ON GROUND AT SUNSET-PM SKY HAD SUN SHINING THROUGH THIN VEIL OF CIRRUS
