Nov-01	PM HAD A FEW CIRRUS CLOUDS AFTER 1530
Nov-02	MORE FROST SEEN ON YARDS THAN ON OCT. 30 BUT DIDN'T KILL TOMATOES
Nov-03	CLOUDY ALL DAY WITH BELOW AVERAGE TEMPERATURES
Nov-04	ALMOST ALL DAY RAIN AND CHILLY AND DAMP DAY-SPRINKLES FROM 1800-2050 AND 4TH PD. OF PRECIP. 2335-2340
Nov-05	CLOUDY UNTIL 0900 THEN CLEAR TO 1300 FOLLOWED BY PARTLY CLOUDY SKIES TO SUNSET
Nov-06	ALTOCUMULUS IN AM AND STRATOCUMULUS IN PM AND SOME ALTOCUMULUS-CHILLY DAY AND FIRST FREEZE PREDICTED FOR TONIGHT
Nov-07	FIRST FREEZE-KILLED GREEN BEANS AND TOMATOES-ALSO A RETROGRADE LOW PRESSURE OFF EAST COAST
Nov-08	NEARLY A HARD FREEZE AND COLDEST SINCE MARCH 27, 2010 WHEN IT WAS ALSO 30 °F
Nov-09	ONLY A LITTLE OF THE CONDENSATION IS FROZEN ON GRASS MOSTLY DEW
Nov-10	BEAUTIFUL FALL DAY AFTER A COOL START-VERY DEEP BLUE SKY
Nov-11	BEAUTIFUL FALL DAY WITH DEEP BLUE SKY AND AGAIN NO CLOUDS SEEN ALL DAY
Nov-12	MORE FROST THAN DEW -VERY LOW REL. HUMIDITY AND MINIMUM DEW POINT TEMP. WAS 20.5 °F AND VERY CLEAR AGAIN
Nov-13	2ND COLDEST AM AFTER NOV. 8 AND FIRST CIRRUS SEEN AROUND 1230 THEN PC AFTER 1430
Nov-14	AM WAS MOSTLY PC WITH SCATTERED CIRRUS ESTIMATED AROUND 30% BUT PM WAS VERY CLEAR
Nov-15	SUN THROUGH AM CIRRUS AND CLOUDINESS INCREASING DURING DAY WITH TOTAL CLOUDINESS FROM NOON TO SUNSET
Nov-16	3RD PD. OF RAIN 1155-1815, 4TH PD. OF PRECIP. 1840-1845
Nov-17	VERY CLEAR AND A BEAUTIFUL FALL DAY AFTER THE STORM DURING THE VERY EARLY AM
Nov-18	AM WAS ABOUT 60% CLOUDY
Nov-19	CLEAR ALL DAY EXCEPT 0920-1000 AND 1530-1700 WHEN SCATTERED CIRRUS CLOUDS CAME IN
Nov-20	NO CLOUDS UNTIL 1530 THEN ONLY THIN CIRRUS
Nov-21	CIRRUS IN AM UNTIL 0830 THEN CLEAR ESTIMATING 25% CLOUDINESS IN PM AND TOTALLY CLEAR-VERY FEW CIRRUS AFTER 1515
Nov-22	VERY DENSE AM FOG-VISIBILITY APPROX. 0.2 MILES-VERY WARM FALL DAY WITH A FEW AM CIRRUS FROM 1045-1130 AND PM CIRRUS AFTER 1530
Nov-23	VERY WARM FALL DAY-BECAME MOSTLY CLOUDY AROUND 1130
Nov-24	SOME CIRRUS FROM 1415 TO SUNSET
Nov-25	CLOUDY ALL DAY AND A MIST AFTER DARK-VERY LIGHT DRIZZLE FROM 2100-2210
Nov-26	COLD FRONT WAS SLOW MOVING THROUGH THE AREA AND NOT MUCH RAIN-3RD PD. OF RAIN 0930-1030
Nov-27	DEEP BLUE SKY-LOW DEW POINT AND REL. HUMIDITY BUT FELT CHILLY BECAUSE OF THE BREEZE
Nov-28	COLDEST SINCE MARCH 7, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 24 °F-THE FIRST VERY HARD FREEZE
Nov-29	HIGHEST BAROMETER SINCE APRIL 14 WHEN PRESSURE REACHED 30.57 INS. -COLDEST MORNING SINCE MARCH 7, 2010-CLOUDS CAME IN ABOUT 1350
Nov-30	MORNING WAS MOSTLY CLOUDY WITH ONLY A LITTLE SUN THROUGH CIRRUS FROM 1015-1045 - HEAVY RAINFALL IN FORECAST FOR MOUNTAINS TONIGHT AND TOMORROW.
