Oct-01	IT WAS ALMOST A TOTALLY CLOUDY DAY UNTIL ABOUT NOON THEN BECAME VERY CLEAR WITH A DEEP BLUE SKY
Oct-02	COOLEST AM SINCE MAY 11, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 43 °F-NO CLOUDS AND A DEEP BLUE SKY
Oct-03	COOLEST DAY SINCE MAY 11 WHEN IT WAS 43 °F- CLEAR UNTIL 1015 THEN PC UNTIL 1145-THEN CLOUDY UNTIL SUNSET
Oct-04	DRIZZLE MOST OF THE PERIOD FROM MIDNIGHT TO 0925-VERY COOL DAY ACCENTUATED BY WIND AND CLOUDINESS-PC FROM 1515-1730
Oct-05	CLOUDY FROM 645-930 AND CLEAR FROM 1030 THEN PARTLY TO MOSTLY CLOUDY TO 1645 EST. PM CLOUDINESS 75%
Oct-06	CIRRUS UNTIL 0900 THEN SOME ALTOCUMULUS AND PM WAS ABOUT 50% CLOUDY WITH CUMULUS AND ALTOCUMULUS
Oct-07	CLEAR ALL DAY ONLY A COUPLE PM CUMULUS SEEN
Oct-08	NO CLOUDS SEEN TODAY AND A DEEP BLUE SKY
Oct-09	LARGE TEMP. RANGE OF 37 °F TODAY-AIRPORT HAD 38 DEGREE TEMP. RANGE & 113 YR REC. FOR DATE-MOSTLY BLUE SKY WITH SOME CUMULUS TO NOON & 1515-1615
Oct-10	ONLY A FEW CUMULUS ALL DAY BUT MAINLY FROM 0945-1000 ON THE NORTH HORIZON
Oct-11	VERY WARM DAY FOR OCT.
Oct-12	THUNDER HEARD TWICE AFTER 1945 AND BEFORE 2015-THE AIRPORT TIED THE REC. HIGH TEMP. FOR DATE SET IN 1962 AND 1954
Oct-13	THE AM WAS ABOUT 70% CLOUDY AND PM HAD MANY CIRRUS WITH SUNLIGHT PASSING THROUGH CLOUDS ABOUT 60% CLOUDY
Oct-14	THUNDER STARTED ABOUT 0628
Oct-15	A VERY CHANGEABLE DAY-AT 0700 MOSTLY CLEAR TO 1000 THEN CIRRUS TO ALTOCUMULUS THEN RAIN AT 1210 THEN CLEARING AGAIN AT 1545
Oct-16	THE 2ND COOLEST AM MIN. TEMP. FOR THE FALL-CLEAR DEEP BLUE SKY ALL DAY
Oct-17	34 DEGREE TEMP. RANGE TODAY AFTER THE COOLEST MIN. SINCE MAY 10, 2010 WHEN IT WAS 39 °F
Oct-18	AM WAS ABOUT 70% CLOUDY BUT SUNLIGHT WAS PASSING THROUGH THIN CLOUDS
Oct-19	AM WAS MOSTLY CLEAR FROM 1030-1150 ONLY
Oct-20	ALMOST AN ALL DAY RAIN
Oct-21	BEAUTIFUL FALL DAY WITH A 73 °F MAX. AND LOW DEW POINT TEMP. AND DEEP BLUE SKY
Oct-22	A LITTLE CHILLY TODAY AND A LITTLE BELOW AVERAGE BUT IT WAS A SUNNY AND VERY CLEAR DAY
Oct-23	OUR FIRST FROST OF THE FALL BUT IT WAS EXTREMELY LIGHT & COULD ONLY BE SEEN ON THE BLACK ASPHALT ROOF-NO FROST SEEN ON THE GROUND
Oct-24	CLOUDY TO AROUND 0950 THEN SUN THROUGH CIRRUS & MOSTLY CLOUDY TO 1215-CLOUDY AGAIN 1230-1430-PM-THEN MOSTLY CLEAR TO SUNSET- ESTIMATED 40% CL
Oct-25	AM WAS ABOUT 75-80% CLOUDY AND PM WAS ABOUT 95% CLOUDY WITH 5 PDS. OF SPRINKLES- 3RD PD. 1515-1520, 4TH PD. 1610-1615, 5TH PD. 1750-1755
Oct-26	CLOUDY ALL DAY WITH SOME VERY LIGHT DRIZZLE AT 1050 & REDUCING VISIBILITY FOR SHORT PD. OF TIME
Oct-27	SOME PM TORNADOS REPORTED NEAR COLD HARBOR ROAD-STORM CENTER PASSED ABOUT 10 MILES TO OUR SOUTH-THIS STORM FORMED AHEAD OF COLD FRONT
Oct-28	HEAVY FOG THIS MORNING AT 0815 AND VISIBILITY WAS REDUCED TEMPORARILY TO ABOUT 0.3 MI. -PROGRESSIVE CLEARING AS DAY PASSED
Oct-29	BEAUTIFUL FALL DAY AFTER A COOL BREEZY AM START THEN A BLUE SKY AND PLEASANT PM TEMPS.
Oct-30	BLACK ASPHALT ROOFS WERE WHITE WITH FROST-LIGHT FROST IN SPOTS ON GRASS-FROZEN DEW ON MIRROR-TOMATOES SURVIVED THE LIGHT FROST
Oct-31	THE A.M. WAS MOSTLY CLOUDY WITH THIN CIRRUS CLOUDS WITH SUNLIGHT PASSING THROUGH AND THE PM WAS VERY CLEAR FROM 1345 AFTER SUNSET

Oct-27	3 PDS. OF RAIN TODAY 1ST FROM 0050-0712 AND 0.64 INS. OF PRECIP. IN AFTERNOON STORM FROM 1624-1740 AND 1.13 INS. IN EVENING STORM FROM 1950-2230 ALSO TODAY
Oct-30	THE RICHMOND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT SET A NEW RECORD HIGH MINIMUM TEMPERATURE OF 70 °F FOR THE DATE; THE OLD RECORD WAS 66 °F IN 1977. THE PM WAS MOSTLY CLOUDY WITH CIRRUS BUT SUNLIGHT WAS PASSING THROUGH THE CLOUDS.
