Feb-03	SUN THROUGH A THIN VEIL OF CIRRUS ALL DAY THAT BECAME THICKER AFTER 1500
Feb-04	STILL BELOW AVERAGE TEMPS. AND WITH CLOUDY DAY MADE IT FEEL EVEN COLDER
Feb-05	3RD PD. OF PRECIP. 1505-1510 AND 4TH PD. 1630-1635-PM WAS ALL DRIZZLE

Feb-13	WIND ALLOWED NO DEW-WINDY, MILD DAY WITH HIGHEST WIND RUN SINCE 12/1/2010
Feb-14	WIND OVER NIGHT NOT ALLOWING DEW-VERY WINDY DAY BUT PLEASANT OTHERWISE-WARMEST SINCE 11/23/2010 WHEN IT WAS 74 DEGREES F
Feb-15	HIGHEST WIND RUN YESTERDAY SINCE 11/12/2009-CLOUDS CAME IN AFTER 1330
